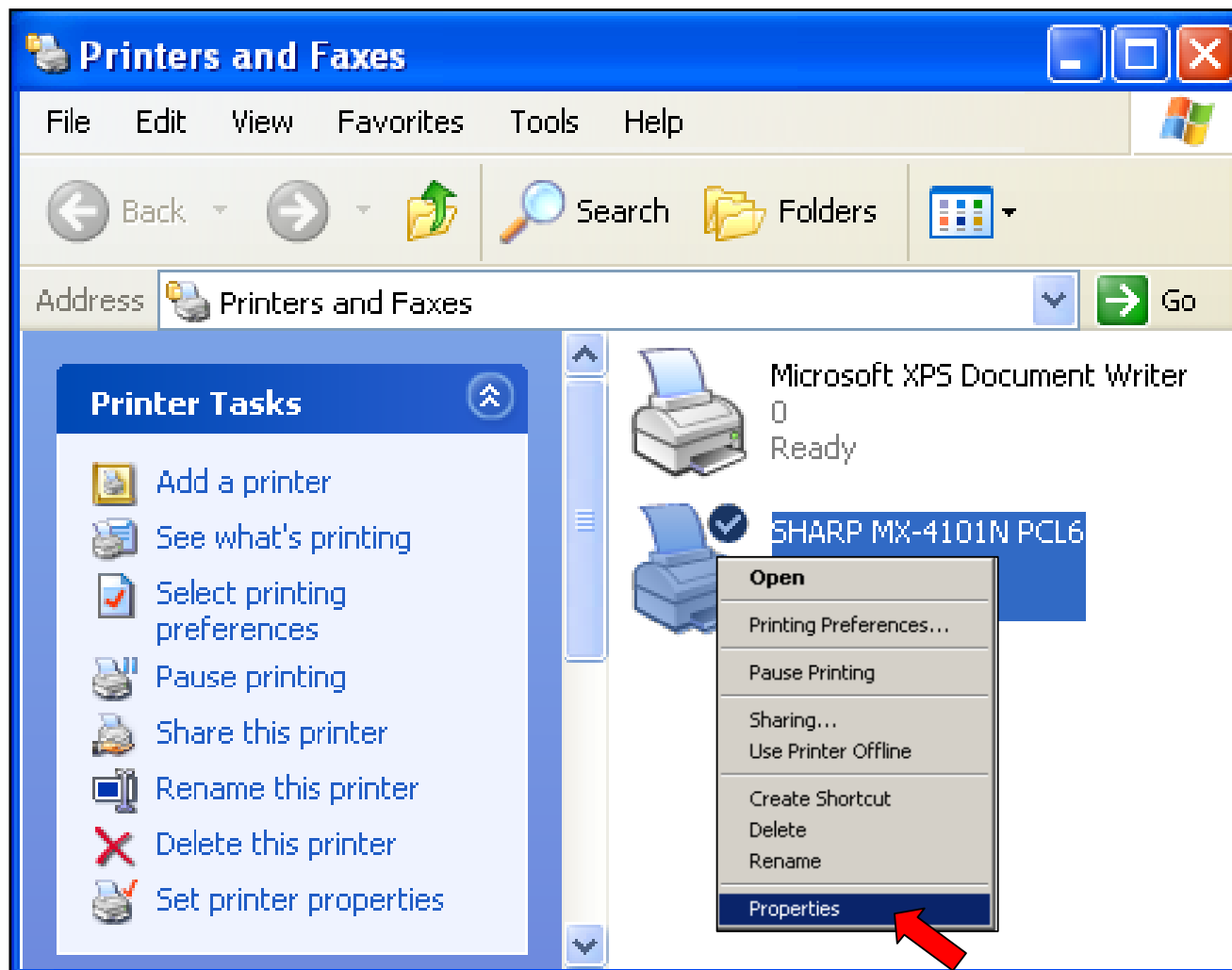




Unchecking SNMP to allow printing (if offline)

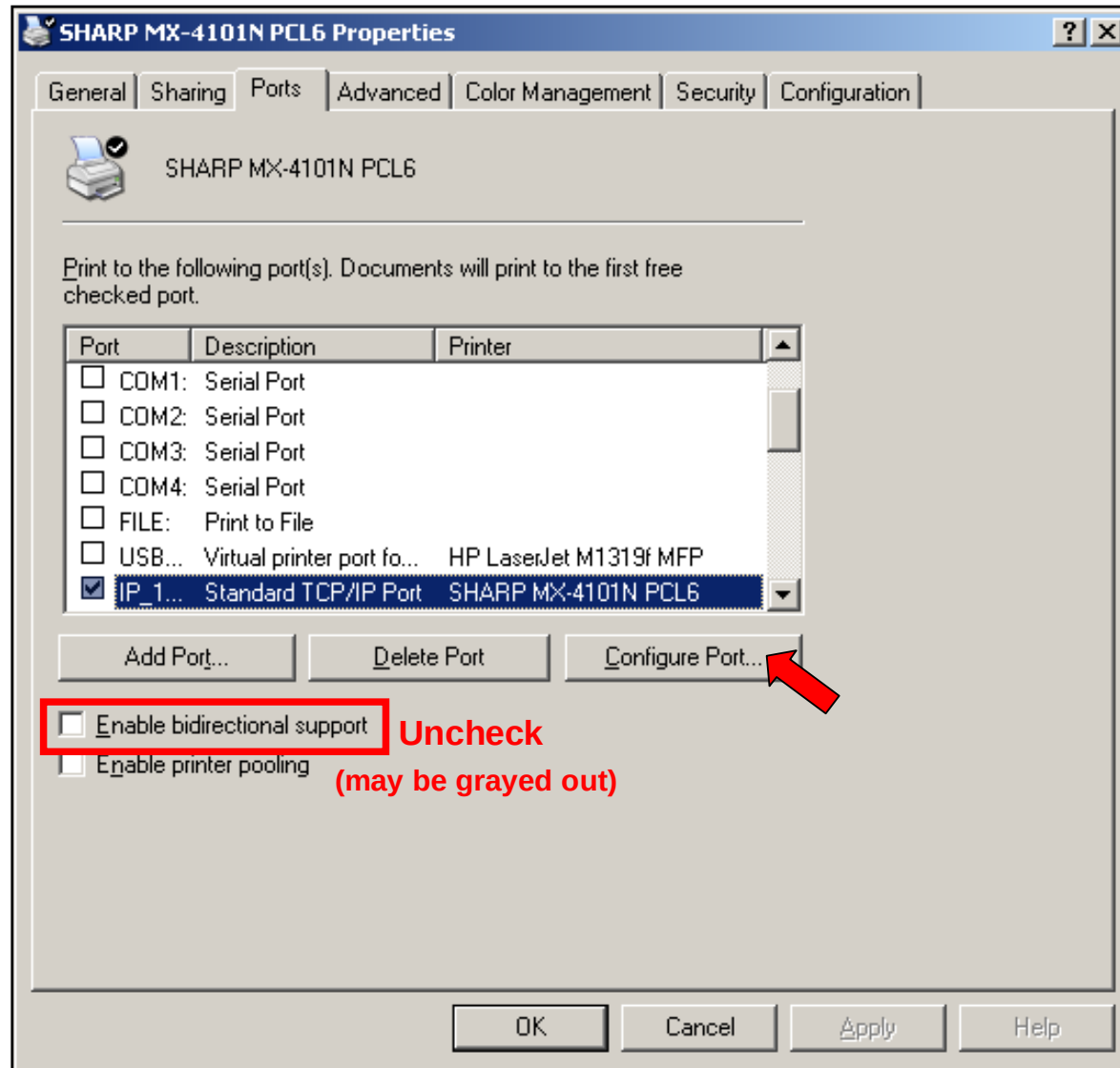
For Windows 2000, XP, Vista, 7

Right-click the Sharp printer and select Properties (Printer Properties for Windows 7).



Note: Screen appearance may vary depending on view settings and/or operating system.

Click the Ports tab. Uncheck the “Enable bidirectional support” box. Click the Configure Port button.



Uncheck the SNMP Status Enabled box and click OK.
